FY2023 Arizona 9-1-1 Program budget prioritization and highlights are:

- \$22,145,685 total funding directly to the Arizona 9-1-1 systems
 - Operational costs for 9-1-1 network services (wireline, wireless, NextGen 9-1-1)
 - Equipment or service for implementing and operating emergency telecommunication services
 - Maintenance costs for 9-1-1 network services
 - GIS projects and resources
 - Extra positions, MSAG equipment, and other technical resources

Agreement packets and information with next steps will be sent to System Administrators. Calls with System Administrators will be scheduled in the upcoming weeks to review and discuss individual awards.
