29 Pursuant to the Case Resolution Stipulation (Doc. 133), ¶ 19, defendant the State  
30 of Arizona (the “State”) hereby submits to the National Association of the Deaf and the  
31 Arizona Center for Disability Law its report identifying the PSAPs within the State, but  
32 outside the Maricopa Region, that have implemented or plan to implement Text-to-911  
33 Services.

34 Text-to-911 funding applications have been submitted by twenty-two PSAPs from  
35 six counties (including Maricopa County for DPS Phoenix). For those PSAPs or 9-1-1  
36 systems that have started implementation, the progress is noted below.

- 1 • Gila County Sheriff's Office. Text-to-911 deployment for the Gila County  
2 Sheriff's Office is in progress. The wireless carriers have been notified to  
3 initiate their project deployment protocols.
- 4 • Payson Police Department. Text-to-911 implementation is in process and  
5 completion of the service activation, the Payson Police Department will be  
6 included in the wireless carrier deployment with the Gila County Sheriff's  
7 Office.
- 8 • Arizona Department of Public Safety (Phoenix, Tucson, and Flagstaff).  
9 The deployment projects for DPS will begin this month.
- 10 • Flagstaff Police Department
- 11 • Grand Canyon NPS
- 12 • Pima 9-1-1 System
- 13 • Santa Cruz 9-1-1 System
- 14 • Yuma 9-1-1 System
